Royal Durban once again hosted the Society's Annual Championship. The weather was near perfect for golf and the golf course and greens were in excellent condition. The championship can only be contested by Full Playing members and is played in 5 age group classes. The "youngest" division is the Class A (55 to 59) age group. It is noteworthy and of some concern that we have only 5 members in this age group while Class B (60 to 64) has 31 members, Class C (65 to 69) has 73 members, Class D (70 to 74) has 51 and finally there are 35 members in Class E 75 and over.
