

### Criteria for Nationals Selections

We have adopted the following process and criteria:

The selection of the members invited to represent the KZN Society is the responsibility of the Captain and Vice-Captain who will be assisted by the Secretary.

### CRITEREA FOR KZN NATIONALS SELECTION

- 1. Performance in previous Nationals must be considered
- 2. Points for inclusion:
  - a. Number of Fixtures played the previous year 1 point per fixture
  - b. Number of Fixtures played 2 years previous 1 point per fixture
  - c. Nationals Max of 8 Points
    - i. Immediate past year National Tournament attended 3 points
    - ii. Year before immediate past Nationals attended 2 points
    - iii. 3 previous Nationals attended (not taking into account the above 2 Nationals) – 3 points (1 point each)
- 3. Winners of the following Trophy events of the Society -- 2 points each
  - a. Annual Championships
    - i. Champion Trophy winner
    - ii. Senior's Annual Trophy winner
  - b. President's Putter
  - c. Bill Edmonds
- 4. Service to the Society will receive favourable consideration

#### • Format of Future Nationals

It has been confirmed that future Nationals will be restricted to 272 players with the Sunday Mixed / Cocktail Reception, and Monday to Thursday format of games starting at 10:00.

Next Nationals is at East London from 19 to 23 April 2020

# **Completion of the Cards**

If the card has the correct format, you need to specify what tee you have elected to play off, your Handicap Index and your Course Handicap. All cards will over time migrate to this format

This is essential for our Handicap Officer, Frans Kemper, to check compliance of scores entered. While overall compliance is good, he does find the following occurrences which are viewed in a serious light if the same person does it more than once:

- Not opening a round and then not entering a good score
- Entering a score higher than achieved.

Ensure you comply, otherwise don't be offended when Frans has to send you a note!
